

This document outlines what The Catholic Traveler, LLC ("TCT") agrees to provide when you sign up for a tour, and what you agree to do in return. This is very important information, so please read it carefully before you complete your reservation request.

Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage

#### **TCT tours are physically demanding**

To enjoy your tour, you should be in good shape. On the most active days we may average several miles of walking (often over uneven paving stones), lots of steep stair-climbing and a fair amount of standing while sightseeing. We will not always be able to pull up directly to the hotel, so be prepared to walk for a few minutes with your luggage. Before you leave, try to get in shape and walk at least an hour every day. Smokers may smoke only outdoors and downwind from the group never in hotel rooms, on buses, or during group meals.

#### **Tour itineraries are subject to change**

Europe is full of surprises and we need to be flexible enough to take advantage of whatever comes along so that we may provide you with the best possible tour. Uncompleted portions of the tour itinerary are not cause for refund.

#### **Tour payments**

To reserve a seat you must agree to these Tour Conditions and provide a deposit of \$300 per person. For deposits and final tour payments we accept personal checks, money orders, MasterCard, Visa and American Express. **Final** payments by credit card require a 3% fee to the amount charged. There are no additional fees to deposits paid by credit card. Your final tour payment is due April 22, 2010. Missing the final payment deadline may result in your being removed from the tour so please make a note of your final payment due date, as shown on your written tour confirmation, as it is your responsibility to pay your final payment in a timely manner.

**Cancellations and refunds**

All deposits are 100% refundable for two weeks from the day they are received. After that time they are not refundable for any reason and will be forfeited if you cancel your tour reservation.

All cancellations must be sent in writing and will be effective on the date received.

Final tour payments may be eligible for some portion of refund if due to qualifying, unforeseen medical or family emergencies as outlined in the "Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage" document. In order to qualify for any reimbursement under our Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage, all tour members are required to complete, sign and return, prior to their tour start date, a Medical Release and Waiver Agreement. On the day the tour begins, or any day thereafter, if you leave the tour for a qualifying, unforeseen medical or family emergency, TCT will refund to you \$75 per person for each missed day. If you leave the tour for a non-qualifying reason, there will be no refund possible.

**Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage**

Please review the included Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage. Understand that to keep costs down, and because it may be unobtainable in any event, The Catholic Traveler has no protection coverage beyond the basic package included in the tour price to protect itself or tour participants themselves, and that tour members intentionally assume the many risks inherent in European travel. All tour members are required to complete, sign and return, prior to their tour start date, a Medical Release and Waiver Agreement. Failure to return a complete and accurate Medical Release Waiver invalidates the Tour Cancellation/Interruption Coverage, and could result in expulsion from a tour at your own expense.

TCT strongly encourages all tour members to purchase separate travel insurance to cover possible additional costs (airline tickets, loss of luggage, trip delay, medical evacuation, etc.).

**Participation**

Although we want everyone to have a good time, it sometimes happens that someone participating in a tour can misbehave or do things that are incompatible with the safety, comfort or convenience of other members of the tour. You agree that in those circumstances we have the exclusive right and discretion, to expel someone, even you, from a tour at any time, without any claims or complaints by you against us.

**Disabilities**

Any pre-existing physical, mental, or emotional disability that may require attention or treatment must be reported in writing prior to the beginning of a tour.

**Tours cancelled by TCT**

Although unlikely, your tour may be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. If TCT cancels a tour you have paid for, the entire amount you have paid to TCT will be refunded to you within fourteen days after the tour's cancellation. Once this occurs, TCT has no other obligations to tour members on cancelled trips including any additional costs or fees related to the issuance and/or cancellation of airline tickets or other travel reservations not made by TCT.
